ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility shall be strictly in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), and the National Medical Commission (NMC), India.

- Allotment letter given by DGHS for admission is subject to fulfillment of all eligibility criteria prescribed by the NMC and medical fitness of the candidates. Those who do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and not found medically fit will not be admitted to the course of study to which they are allotted by the DGHS.

- The candidates should report along with Original Certificates and Proof of fee payment in the Portal.

- **The following Certificates should be submitted in original along with 1 set of photocopies.**

1. Provisional Allotment letter from DGHS/mcc.nic.in
2. NEET UG 2026 Admit card issued by NTA
3. NEET UG 2026 Rank letter/ Score card issued by NTA

8. Conduct Certificate
9. Migration Certificate (not applicable for state board students)
10. Caste Certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL if applicable)*OBC-NCL certificate (as per Central list) is mandatory if the candidate has applied under that category. BC/MBC certificates will not be considered.
11. EWS Certificate (if applicable – for Candidates falling under General Economically Weaker Section (GEN-EWS) category)**
12. Disability Certificate (if applicable - for physically disabled; as per the guidelines prescribed by NTA under Reservation Policy for PwD Candidates)***
13. Photocopy of PAN Card of the parent
14. Photocopy of Aadhar Card of parent and candidate
15. Four passport size recent photographs (same as affixed in NEET UG 2026 Admit card)

Degrees / Certificates of candidates must have been recognized and approved by the Association of Indian universities / Commonwealth Universities / International Association of Universities as equivalent to the corresponding Indian degrees / certificates

- The Candidate should also produce the following Certificate/s, if applicable:
 - a) *SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the standard format as mentioned in the Annexure 3 of UG information bulletin 2026 of Medical Counseling Committee (MCC)

and it should be in English or Hindi in language. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate. Some States insist on an English version of Caste Certificate. In case the certificate is in regional language the candidate should carry an attested translated copy of the certificate in English/ Hindi.

- b) *Other Backward Classes (OBC-NCL) - Non Creamy Layer certificate as per the Central List of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website (www.ncbc.nic.in). State list OBC-NCL Candidates who are not in OBC-NCL (Central List) will fall under General Category. The sub- caste should tall with the Central List of OBC. The OBC certificate must be in the standard format as mentioned in the Annexure 4 of UG information bulletin 2025 of Medical Counseling Committee (MCC).
- c) **Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Certificate - As per the OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated January 17, 2019 issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and the OM No. 12-4/2019- U1 dated 17.01.2019 as well as the Letters No 35-2/2019-T.S.I dated 21.01.2019, 01.02.2019, 04.02.2019 and 15.02.2019 of MHRD Department of Higher Education regarding implementation of reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) for admission in Central Educational Institutions. (Annexure 5 of UG information bulletin 2025 of Medical Counseling Committee (MCC)).
- d) ***PwD certificate issued by the Competent Authority, if claiming the relaxation under PwD category. Benchmark Disabilities in accordance with the Provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016 and as per MCI guidelines dated May 13, 2019. (Please refer to the Annexures 1 & 2 of UG information bulletin 2025 of Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) for details). No other PH certificate, issued by any other Authority/Hospital will be entertained.
- Candidates without original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission in the allotted Medical College.
- Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other institute/ college/ University and come for admission with a certificate stating that “their original certificates are deposited with institute/college/University” shall not be allowed to take admission in the allotted Medical College.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- If a candidate fails to report on the date and time specified by MCC of DGHS in the allotment order along with the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee by Demand Draft/Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS with UTR No. on the day of admission, he/she will not be permitted to proceed with the admission process. The vacancy arising there from will be duly notified to the DGHS.
- If any candidate withdraws from the course of study in which he/she was admitted, after the expiry of the cut-off date prescribed for admission to that course of study or in mid-term and

the seat is rendered vacant, the first year fee paid will be forfeited and the student will also be required to remit the “entire course fee” for the remaining years of the course period.

- iii. Students will be governed by all the University rules including rules for refund of fee, disciplinary rules, hostel rules and UGC/NMC Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging.
- iv. At the time of admission, candidates should sign declaration/undertakings declaring that they shall abide by the rules and regulation of the University including Anti-ragging Regulations of the UGC/NMC and observe good conduct and behavior and that they are bound by the University rules on payment of fees/refund of fees.
